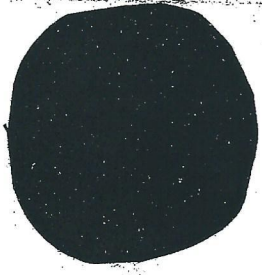

 Company 32nd Regiment of Georgia Volunteers Commanded by
 Colonel G P Harrison in the service of the Confederate States in
 the present war with the United States that the said Robert
 J Collier ~~at~~ entered the service at Thomaston in Upson County
 and State of Georgia on or about the 3rd day of May 1862
 and died at Savannah Georgia from sickness on or about the
 29th day of June 1862 leaving deponent his widow surviving
 him that deponent makes this deposition for the purpose of
 obtaining from the Government of the Confederate States whatever
 may have been due the said Robert J Collier at the time of his
 death for pay bounty or other allowances for his services as aforesaid
 Sworn to and subscribed before } Sarah E Collier
 me this the 17th day of January 1863 }

 known to me and whom I hereby certify to be a person of veracity
 and credibility who having been by me duly sworn says on oath

 and also well knew for ten years Robert J Collier the deceased
 Soldier herein mentioned and that the statements made under
 oath by said Sarah E Collier claimant as to her relationship
 to said deceased Soldier is true and correct in every particular
 to the best of his knowledge and belief and that he the said
 deponent is wholly disinterested — Sworn to and subscribed
