I have had the pleasure of two visits from your son, Mr. D. C. Collier of 521 Fifth Avenue, New York.

Mr. Collier and I have gone over the matter of the two historical silver beakers of Vines Collier and his wife Sara of the 18th Century. I had these beakers here on Mr. Collier's last visit yesterday afternoon.

As per requested, I have had these two beakers photographed and enclose you herewith a print of this negative. On the reverse of the picture, I have noted the size, weight and also a transcript of the note made by the late Dr. Norton, and which is fixed on the inside of the "Sara" beaker. This reads as follows -

C.A.Q.N.

My impression is that Dr. Norton was with the Union Army with General Sherman on his march to the Sea from Atlanta.
